Golborne Sports Junior Football Club was formed in 1992 by Steve Horrigan and Paul Dawson with just 14 or so boys and a couple of enthusiastic parents. The aim then and today is to provide the children within the Lowton & Golborne area with an opportunity to participate in football and its associated activities at an affordable and cost efficient price. The junior section has now over 300 children involved from the ages or 5 to 18 and is now an integral part of the local community. We currently run 29 teams in both the Warrington & Wigan Junior football leagues and have over 50 qualified coaches who all give their time voluntarily (all our coaches are CRB checked). But our development as a club is not just about children as each year we try to recruit and encourage "new" volunteers to become involved, many attend the FA coaching courses and this constant recruitment and development program helps us to continue to put the "children first". The Junior Football Club is a not for profit organisation.

In June 2012 the club gained The FA Charter Standard Club award. In January 2013 the club attained The FA Charter Standard Community Club Award. In 2013 our club was awarded the FA Charter Standard Community Club of the Year for Lancashire. As well as being nominated for a National FA Respect Award.

We follow a strong ethos that our primary objective is to provide the local children with high quality (good) standard of training and we encourage physical activity and more importantly fun. We also encourage children to participate in football matches in line with the Football Association guidelines for mini and youth football, but whilst we always want our teams and players to do well we think it is vital that all our children know that participation is far more important than a win at all costs attitude.

Training takes place at Golborne Sports Club and the pitches at Golborne High School, with home games also played at Golborne High School playing fields.
